**LOGLINE**: A Little Fellow: The Legacy of A.P. Giannini tells the extraordinary journey of a first-generation immigrant who defied the odds to become a pioneering entrepreneur, creating a new and inclusive bank, and championing dreamers from the working class to Walt Disney.

**SYNOPSIS**: Before banks were on every corner, there was a time when getting a loan and saving money was a privilege. Then, in the early 1900s, A.P. Giannini revolutionized American finance. Born to Italian immigrant parents, Giannini started by selling produce until he saw a need in his community that was going ignored: a bank for the people. Believing that everyone – including women, the working poor, and immigrants – should have access to banking services, Giannini opened a bank for the "little fellow." This documentary is about a man who went from small-time banker to founding Bank of America. His imagination and vision for America took him beyond banking as he influenced Hollywood, the Golden Gate Bridge, and early Silicon Valley. This is the story of a pioneer who defied the odds to become a titan of industry... while staying true to "the little fellow".

**FESTIVALS & PREMIERES**: A Little Fellow team is currently applying to major film festivals and it's seeking collaborations for the Los Angeles and San Francisco premieres with filmmakers' Q&A.
